ORDINANCE NO. M-4283

AN ORDINANCE relating to the collection of solid waste, recyclable materials and organics, and amending certain sections of VMC 6.12 to increase or adjust rates and charges consistent with approved utility user taxes and rates and in accordance with current contracts for the coming year; providing for savings, severability and an effective date.

WHEREAS, solid waste collection, residential recycling, and organics rates within VMC 6.12 were last changed by adoption of Ordinance M-4264 (February 25, 2019), and current rates became effective April 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Utility Tax rate, VMC 5.94, is set to increase by 1.6 percent to 28.9 percent on January 1, 2020, through adoption of Ordinance M-4239 (October 1, 2018), to be used for the purpose of funding police staffing and associated services in a manner generally consistent with the community resource team recommendations dated December 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, such changes in the utility tax rate for solid waste will require changes to the solid waste rates that are incorporated in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, utility taxes are applied to the gross revenues of each utility; and

WHEREAS, utility rates need to be increased to ensure each utility collects the same amount of revenue it did prior to the utility tax increase; and

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WHEREAS, the City's contract for Comprehensive Garbage, Recyclables, and Organics Collection Services, effective April 1, 2019, contains provisions for annual adjustments to rates charged by the Contractor based upon changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI), a Fuel Index, changes in disposal tipping fees, and changes in the City fee as calculated through the contract's Exhibit D rate model; and

WHEREAS, the Inflation Adjustment Factor (IAF) for rates set for the 2020 period has been calculated at 2.31% by combining a 2.229 percent increase in the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue CPI-W and a 10.05% percent increase in the Fuel Index (weighted 92 percent and 8 percent respectively) factored at 80 percent as the allowed annual compensation adjustment for the collection contractor; and

WHEREAS, per Clark County contract provisions with the facility operator, disposal fees at transfer stations used to dispose of waste collected by the Contractor under the specifications of the comprehensive collection contract are set to increase by 0.16 percent to \$95.86 per ton of municipal solid waste effective January 1, 2020, and

WHEREAS, Clark County established a recyclables processing fee on February 19, 2019 to be paid for residential recyclables delivered under the waste recycling, transfer and disposal contract with Columbia Resources Company, which is set to increase from \$68.91 per ton to \$74.76 per ton on January 1, 2020, impacting the recyclables processing surcharge amounts established for City curbside and multi-family customers; and

WHEREAS, the City's comprehensive collection contract also contains provisions for annual adjustments in compensation of rates for recycling and organics collection services based on the above noted changes in the IAF and fuel index; and

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WHEREAS, Section 4.3.2 of the City’s comprehensive collection contract provides for an increase in the Organics rates, above the inflationary adjustment, if changes in law or regulations impact the operational and capital costs at the designated organics processing site. Air quality permit requirements at the Dirt Hugger location in Dallesport, WA have been added in the past six months which justify an increase of \$0.20 per month in the organics rates above the IAF related increase; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit D of the contract will be utilized once rates are approved to adjust the monthly City Fee payments for 2020 to accurately balance approved compensation to the contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VANCOUVER:

Rates for compacted solid waste apply only when such waste has been compacted by any mechanical device prior to its pickup by the collector. Loose waste dumped into the collector's packer truck from a container will be subject to the rates for non-compacted material. However, waste that has been compressed or compacted by any mechanical device and then subsequently dumped into a loose yard container to be picked up by the Contractor shall be subject to compacted container rates only upon prior written approval of the Director.

Overweight charges for container service: If the Contractor identifies that a Customer's disposal weights are consistently in excess of 130 lbs. per loose yard (if charged loose container rates) or 455 lbs. per compacted yard, or per yard of heavy material such as dirt, rock, etc. (if charged compacted container rates) the Contractor may charge a flat overweight surcharge in addition to the regular rates. The surcharge will be equal to the weight in excess of 200 pounds per loose yard or 700 pounds per compacted yard multiplied by the current disposal rates per pound, multiplied by the number of yards serviced per month. The surcharge may also be applied to any extra or special pickups. The Contractor shall not charge the overweight container charge until the on-going overweight account has been brought to the attention of the Director. The Contractor may charge the overweight charge once the Director has investigated the issue and made a written determination as to whether or not the proposed charge is appropriate to the situation.

Section 6. VMC 6.12.213, adopted by Ordinance M-3069 and last amended by Ordinance M-4264, is amended as follows:

6.12.213 Residential recycling fees.

The following fees shall be charged for recycling program costs within the City of Vancouver:

1. *Curbside Recycling*
 - a. For each dwelling unit in a structure containing from one to four residential dwelling units, ~~\$3.20~~ 3.27 per month.
 - b. For each dwelling unit in a structure containing from one to four residential dwelling units, the contractor may invoice a “recyclables processing surcharge” of ~~\$1.77~~ 1.59 per month.
2. *Multi-family Recycling*

c. Five or more residential dwelling units on a consolidated solid waste collection bill, ~~\$1.29~~ 1.32 per month per unit.

d. For each dwelling unit in a structure containing five or more residential dwelling units, the contractor may invoice a “recyclables processing surcharge” of ~~\$0.78~~ 0.84 per unit per month.

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Section 8. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such order or judgment shall be confined in its operation to the controversy in which it was rendered and shall not effect or invalidate the remainder of any parts thereof to any person or circumstances and to this end the provisions of each clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this law are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 9. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective as of January 1, 2020, following the date of final adoption.
